



## bioWAVE Port Fairy Project

Mariners are advised of the establishment a temporary marine exclusion zone in the vicinity of Taylors Bay, west of Port Fairy, Western Victoria. Mariners are advised that a wave energy conversion device (bioWAVE), a subsea cable and scientific equipment are being placed on the sea bed near Taylors Bay; about 6 km west of Port Fairy.

Marine transit and exclusion zones will be established from 12 November 2015 till 1 July 2017. The marine zoning (refer to maps) will consist of two distinct zones.

The exclusion zone will consist of a 150 m radius circle established by two cardinal buoys (North and South). All vessels are prohibited in the exclusion zone unless authorised by TSV and BPS.

The transit zone will consist of a 200 m wide corridor defined as being 100 m westerly and 100 m easterly of a line defined by the onshore Day Mark and the North Buoy. The operator, master or person in charge of a vessel must not use the transit zone other than for transiting of the vessel and must not permit the vessel to be anchored in or allow the vessel to drift in the transit zone. Fishing, netting or trawling is prohibited within the transit zone unless authorised by TSV and BPS.

Latitude and longitude positions are on WGS84 horizontal datum and are compatible with GDA94 datum.
